Author? Text /visual (language/ colors, images)? Reader?

Bio. / Historical Movement- claimed that it is important to know the life of the author and the

historical time period when the book / art was created to better understand the meaning.

Ex: the book by Oscar Wilde - The Picture of Dorian Gray

Author intent/purpose Bio (life) Time period when the book is created Tone

Structuralism Movement

Text (language)? Grammar, <u>punctuation</u>: "Let's eat<mark>,</mark> grandma".vs. "Let's eat grandma."

Boy's football / 3 boys' football class is on every Saturday or Boys Football

Hot- warning/no touch. Hot girl- want to touch

Baby- noun Baby boy (baby- adjective)

Translation- changes meaning

Ex: The lion ate the man.

Denotation / Connotation Love (assumed/given meaning) (dictionary meaning)

Also, for the deeper meaning, consider INSIGHTS and COMPLEXITY

- INSIGHT= consider the details in the text to understand the bigger ideas
- **COMPLEXITY=** consider <u>the bigger ideas</u> (social norms, ideologies of the time) <u>to understand the</u> <u>details of the text</u>

Readers' opinion matters Mood Background (education level) Gender, age Purpose

Watch the movie: <u>The Vantage Point</u> – where the beginning of the movie re-starts from different perspectives

Process Movement 1963

Reading: ACTIVE READING-Communication between the author and the reader via text

• <u>New Definitions for:</u>

Text: anything that has meaning: symbols, image, video, vocal, movie, writing (c u 2- ⁽³⁾) **Reading:** not only written info, visual, sounds, image

- All the 3 agents (author, text, reader) are participating in Meaning Creation
- 3 pass / step Process to Active Reading:
- **1. Pre-view:** <u>Before you read the text:</u> consider the author's life, tone, purpose, time period
- 2. Reading for Meaning: pay attention to the details in the text/ deeper meaning

3. Reading with Critical Attitude (reader uses critical thinking to express opinion, to connect/ apply to their life to the real moment, reader evaluates the text/image.)

THE MEANING is created if we engage in **ACTIVE READING**- if we do the **3 steps of the reading process** that include considering the 3 agents: Author / Text-visual / Reader

3 steps of Active Reading

1. Pre-view: consider the creator of the image and the time period

2. Reading for Meaning: consider the details of the image

3. Reading with Critical Attitude- consider your interpretation of the meaning of this image based on the Steps 1 and 2 plus your knowledge

(Ex. "Me Too" movement. The meaning of "Beauty" in 21st century with plastic surgeries and Photoshop ...)
