 - Complete thought (.)
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The Members of Sentences

1. **Subject:** Simple, Complete
 2. **Predicate (Verb):** Simple, Complete Ex: My little sister Anna is singing very well in the shower.
 3. **Object:** Direct, Indirect, Prepositional Object
 4. **Complements (adjectives):** Subject Complement and Object Complement
 5. **Modifiers (adjectives/ adverb)** of time, place, type....
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
